## DISTRICT ATTORNEY PROMOTES TWO PROSECUTORS TO SUPERVISOR POSITIONS

District Attorney Tim Ward is pleased to announce the promotion of two Tulare County prosecutors to the position of Supervising Deputy District Attorney.

Mitch Niayesh began his career as a TCDA prosecutor in 2003. During his tenure, he has prosecuted cases as part of the general misdemeanor and felony teams, white collar crime, auto theft, homicide, and post-conviction law and motions. He was awarded Attorney of the Year by the Porterville Exchange Club in 2014. Niayesh holds an undergraduate degree in civil engineering from the University of West Virginia and a Master's Degree in engineering mechanics from California State University, Fullerton. He obtained his Juris Doctor from Golden Gate University School of Law in San Francisco in 2001.
